

VEHICLE REGISTRATION

Keeping vehicle registration is critical in keeping your vehicle compliant and on the right side of the law.

Confirm your credentials

Before driving always make sure you have a valid driver license plate, copy of your registration (paper or electronic), registration sticker and valid inspection stickers (if required).

Check your requirements

If vehicle inspection tests are required to successfully renew your registration, follow all state or provincial guidelines.

*If your company requests, Wheels will alert you of what is required – send in as soon as possible!

Plan ahead

Confirm if motor vehicle facilities, emissions stations and repair shops require appointments to complete inspections, then schedule early. Additionally some jurisdictions require original copies of inspections; remember to allow additional time for mailing requirements.

Stay connected

Keep tabs on local and state or provincial vehicle laws and regulations. Remember that license plate information and registration documents are available on the Wheels Mobile Assistant and in Driver Tools.
